### 1. Identify Brand & Model

- Find model & serial number
- Note age & features
- Take photos of parts

### 2. OEM vs Aftermarket

- Genuine manufacturer parts
  - Aftermarket replacements
- Balance cost vs durability*

### 3. Check Compatibility

- Match shape, size, style
- Check motor, pedal, tension parts
- Use diagrams/manuals

### 4. Sources to Explore

- Dealers, online stores, forums, repair shops
- Specialists may stock rare parts*

### 5. Inspect Before Buying

- Check item photos & condition
  - Review return policy
- Metal parts often fine used*

### 6. Red Flags

- Avoid vague listings, stock photos
  - Beware unknown sellers
- Contact seller if unsure*

### 7. Shipping & Cost

- Compare delivery time vs price
  - Consider import taxes
- Local may save time*

### 8. Testing & Installation

- Test fit before full install
- Use proper tools
- Keep old parts until sure
